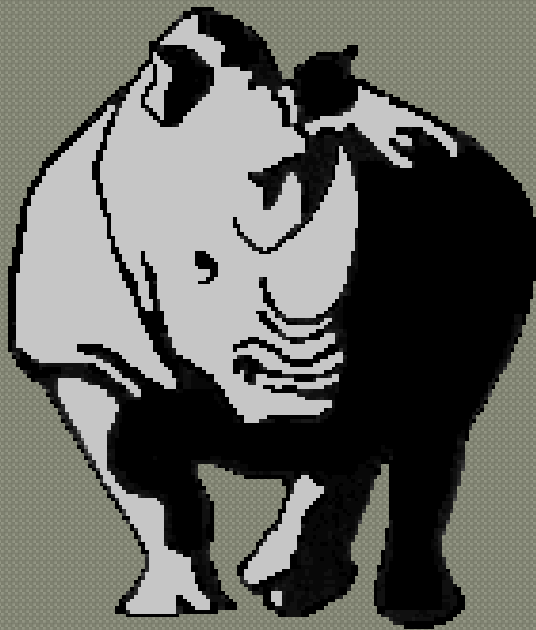

In 2008 as a result of the Virginia General Assembly granting the authority for members of Commonwealth Attorney Offices serving as prosecutors to carry firearms; AggDefSol was approached by Harvey Bryant, the Commonwealth's Attorney for the city of Virginia Beach.

This course provides the prosecutor with a viable working knowledge that will assist in the presentation of cases and determination of procedural aspects of the case.

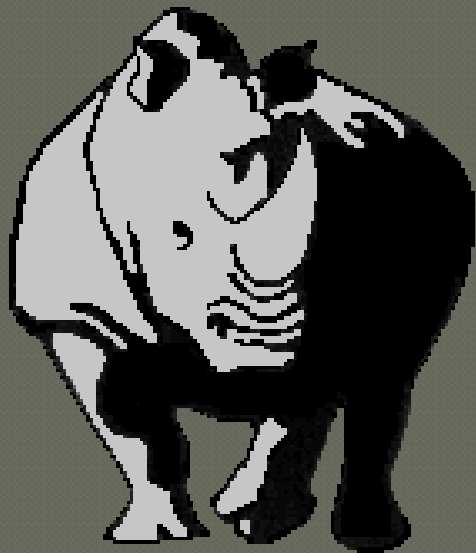
Options for Training
